NOTICE OF ONLINE JOINT BOARD MEETING with BSD BOARD and CHARTER BOARD

NOTICE is hereby given that a telephonic, online regular meeting of the Governing Board of the Burton School District is hereby called by the board president and will be held at 5:15 p.m. on March 29, 2021.

The District is taking all necessary steps to prevent and mitigate the effects of COVID-19 on our community. Therefore in the interest of public health, and in compliance with California Governor Gavin Newsom's recently issued Executive Orders N-25-20 and N-35-20, the California State Public Health Officer's Order, including social distancing guidelines and avoiding group gatherings, and all applicable provisions of federal and state law, this Board meeting will be held telephonically and online. All Board members, staff and others presenting at the meeting will be calling in via the Zoom video conferencing platform from separate locations.

Unfortunately, physical attendance by the public cannot be accommodated given the current circumstances and the need to ensure the health and safety of the members, staff, and the public as a whole; however, the District is making significant efforts to ensure public participation during this Board meeting, and has taken the following steps to help the public access the meeting:

1. Electronic Submission of Public Comments. Public Comments for a non-agenda or agendized item may be emailed to sdavila@burtonschools.org. In the subject line, please identify, as applicable, the agenda item the comment addresses, including the agenda item number and title. If you wish to submit a public comment on more than one agenda item, please send a separate e-mail for each item on which you are commenting. Any relevant written comment submitted by 4:00 p.m. on March 29, 2021 will be read on the record during this meeting.

All public comments will be limited to 3 minutes, a limit of approximately 450 words. Any portion of your comment extending past the 450 word limit may not be read aloud due to time restrictions. All written comments that are not read into the record will be made part of the meeting minutes, provided that such comments are received prior to the end of the meeting. Please be aware that written public comments, including your name, may become public information.

2. Zoom Video Conferencing. Members of the public can call into the meeting to observe via the Zoom video conferencing platform. Members of the public can access Zoom from a computer, mobile device or tablet.

Members of the public can "raise your hand" to request to make oral public comments during the meeting. Instructions will be provided at the appropriate times during the meeting.

3. Disability Accommodations. If you need special assistance to participate in a Board meeting, please contact the Superintendent's Office at (559) 781-8020. Notification at least 48 hours prior to a meeting will assist the staff in ensuring that reasonable accommodations can be made.

4. Closed Session Access. Should the Board have agenda items in closed session, only individuals relevant to such items will be provided separate telephonic meeting access information. An approximate time of when the open session of the meeting will recommence may be provided to individuals waiting on the original telephonic call and reasonable efforts will be made by staff to notify and update the public of when the Board will reconvene in open session.
